Program Update:

The debriefing for the returning 6 IFYEs (10 country experiences in 2017) will be held in Washington, D.C. from December 7-10, 2017. A complete review of the program (from application to return from host country), promoting IFYE after their return, and discussion of reverse culture shock will be included in the debriefing. Fourteen (14) countries were part of the 2017 IFYE program including the Inbound IFYE exchange.

The National Program Director (NPD), Alan Lambert, has received three IFYE applications for the 2018 program. The goal is to have 12 outbounds in 2018. Approximately 60 individuals have indicated interest this year and the NPD is following up on more than 100 who have expressed interest in past years. Applications will be forwarded to IFYE State Coordinators where applicable. Applicant interviews will be conducted as soon as possible with help from area IFYE alumni and others who have assisted in the past. Interest in a three-month program is increasing as applicants are attempting to fit IFYE in between the spring and fall semesters at their universities. A \$500 recruitment award is available to all IFYE alumni for finding an IFYE for 2018. Contact Alan for details.

The IFYEs that participated in 2016 and 2017 are eager to provide presentations and a recently adopted financial incentive is available for them to make a presentation to your group.

Board Update:

- Recently returning IFYE Tiffany Hulinsky (2015 IFYE Minn. to Finland) has joined the IFYE board! She is joining Pat Hutsell (1972 IFYE Neb. to Kenya), Jan Dennis Wood (1972 IFYE Ohio to Australia) and Jess Stairs (1964 IFYE Penn. to India). Their three-year terms will begin in 2018 but they are involved now in committee work and board conference calls. (*In the last issue, it was erroneously reported that Jess went to Italy. Sorry for the error, Jess. Thanks to the IFYEs who were in Italy for catching the error.*)
- Board officers for 2018 are Art Deisher, President; Larry Gould, Vice-President; Victoria Warren, Secretary and Immediate Past President; and Larry Hancock, Treasurer. Appointed Associate Treasurer for 2018 is Don DeWerff. All are incumbent officers except Victoria who is becoming Secretary for the retiring Connie Fukudome.
- The 2018 National Board meeting will be in Indianapolis, Indiana on July 6-8. Location yet to be determined.

Financial Update:

- The 2018 IFYE budget was approved by the IFYE Board in November. It is available upon request. Outside funding sources to be obtained by the Executive Director will hold the need for alumni contributions to \$10,000 per month. If half of the IFYE alumni donated just \$10 per month, the income would almost be double the need!
- It is recognized that many of you make donations. We greatly appreciate your generosity and want you to continue your support. The alumni portion of the budget is \$10,000 per month and historically donations have exceeded that level. We need that to continue.
